Cycle 2 of the MIPP Mentorship Programme will begin in September 2024 and finish in August 2025

THE PROGRAMME



You will be matched with a senior leader from the Civil Service or Local Government to support you whilst you are early in your public policy & professional career.

This programme is aimed at those from lower socioeconomic backgrounds to realise their full potential to help build confidence, aspiration and aid progression. We prefer applications from professionals with minimum 2-3 years professional experience.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

A mentoring relationship requires commitment from both mentee and mentor to meet at least four times over the period of the programme.

- Mentees will need to prepare for these meetings and undertake any activity suggested by mentors.
- Mentors are there to challenge, advise and support as well as to use their knowledge and skills to help you.



YOUR ROLE AS MENTEE

- Take responsibility for your own development.
- Be proactive and come prepared.
- Identify what you expect to gain from your mentor.
- Open communication is vital.
- Be open to feedback.
- Enjoy the experience!
